This supplement contains amendments to the Jacobsens Harmonized Customs Tariff arising from amendments which were published in the following *Government Gazettes*:

- *Government Gazette No. 41633* dated 18 May 2018
- *Government Gazette No. 41641* dated 21 May 2018
- *Government Gazette No. 41651* dated 25 May 2018
- *Government Gazette No 41668* dated 1 June 2018

### NOTES REGARDING THE AMENDMENTS TO THE SAFEGUARD DUTY ON CERTAIN HOT-ROLLED STEEL PRODUCTS

Certain hot-rolled steel products, classifiable under subheading 7225.99, are currently subject to safeguard duty at a rate of 12%.

The safeguard duty will be reduced by 2% per annum **with effect from 11 August 2018 and 11 August 2019 and will expire on 10 August 2020.**

Following an application for the reduction of the safeguard duty, the International Trade Administration Commission of South Africa (ITAC) made a recommendation in Report 575 of 19 March 2018 that the safeguard duty be rebated through the creation of a temporary rebate provision under Schedule No. 4 to the Customs and Excise Act, subject to an ITAC permit, issued in terms of guidelines, and subject to certain rules and conditions.

1. In terms of Section 75 of the Customs and Excise Act, 1964, Part 2 of Schedule No. 4 to the said Act is amended by the insertion of rebate item 460.15/7225.99/01.06.

The three safeguard duty provisions have also been amended to exclude steel products which have been imported under the rebate provision as per notices below:

2. In terms of Section 57 of the Customs and Excise Act, 1964, Part 3 of Schedule No. 2 to the said Act is amended, **up to and including 10 August 2018.**

**In addition to the amendments above, there were also the following amendments:**

5. In terms of Section 60 of the Customs and Excise Act, 1964, Schedule No. 8 to the said Act is amended:

By the substitution of items 820.05 and 820.10 to extend the validity period for licenses for pot stills.

6. In terms of Section 48 of the Customs and Excise Act, 1964, Part 1 of Schedule No. 1 to the said Act is amended to the extent indicated below:

The rates of duty on canola seed, classifiable under international tariff subheading 1205.10 is reduced by the creation of two new subheadings, 1205.10.20 and 1205.10.90, to implement the ITAC recommendation in Report 574.

ITAC also recommended that an additional note be inserted to define the scope of subheading 1205.10.20. Therefore, Additional Note 1 to Chapter 12 was inserted.

7. In terms of section 75 of the Customs and Excise Act, 1964, Part 1D of Schedule No. 6 to the said Act is amended:

By the insertion of various items under rebate item 621.08 to make provision of a rebate of full duty in respect of ethyl alcohol by-product that has been used for industrial purposes or for the manufacture of other non-liquor products.

8. In terms of Section 48 of the Customs and Excise Act, 1964, Part 1 of Schedule No. 1 to the said Act is amended to the extent indicated below:

The rates of duty on wheat and wheaten flour classifiable in tariff subheadings 1001.91 and 1001.99 as well as 1101.00.10 and 1101.00.90 have been increased from 29,38c/kg and 44,06c/kg to 43,72c/kg and 65,59c/kg respectively, in terms of the existing variable tariff formula as recommended in ITAC Minute 04/2018.

9. In terms of Section 75 of the Customs and Excise Act, 1964, Part 1 of Schedule No. 4 to the said Act is amended to the extent indicated below:

Rebate items 405.04/00.00/01.00 and 405.04/00.00/02.00 are amended to review the wording providing for goods for disabled persons or for the upliftment of indigent persons as recommended in ITAC Minute M15/2017.

CHAPTER 11

PRODUCTS OF THE MILLING INDUSTRY; MALT; STARCHES; INULIN; WHEAT GLUTEN

Chapter Notes:

1. This Chapter does not cover the following:
  - (a) Roasted malt put up as coffee substitutes (heading 09.01 or 21.01);
  - (b) Prepared flours, groats, meals or starches of heading 19.01;
  - (c) Corn flakes or other products of heading 19.04;
  - (d) Vegetables, prepared or preserved, of heading 20.01, 20.04 or 20.05;
  - (e) Pharmaceutical products (Chapter 30); or
  - (f) Starches having the character of perfumery, cosmetic or toilet preparations (Chapter 33).
2. (A) Products from the milling of the cereals listed in the table below fall in this Chapter if they have, by mass on the dry product:
  - (a) a starch content (determined by the modified Ewers polarimetric method) exceeding that indicated in Column (2); and
  - (b) an ash content (after deduction of any added minerals) not exceeding that indicated in Column (3). Otherwise, they fall in heading 23.02. However, germ of cereals, whole, rolled, flaked or ground is always classified in heading 11.04.
 (B) Products falling in this Chapter under the above provisions shall be classified in heading 11.01 or 11.02 if the percentage passing through a woven metal wire cloth sieve with the aperture indicated in Column (4) or (5) is not less, by mass, than that shown against the cereal concerned. Otherwise they fall in heading 11.03 or 11.04.
